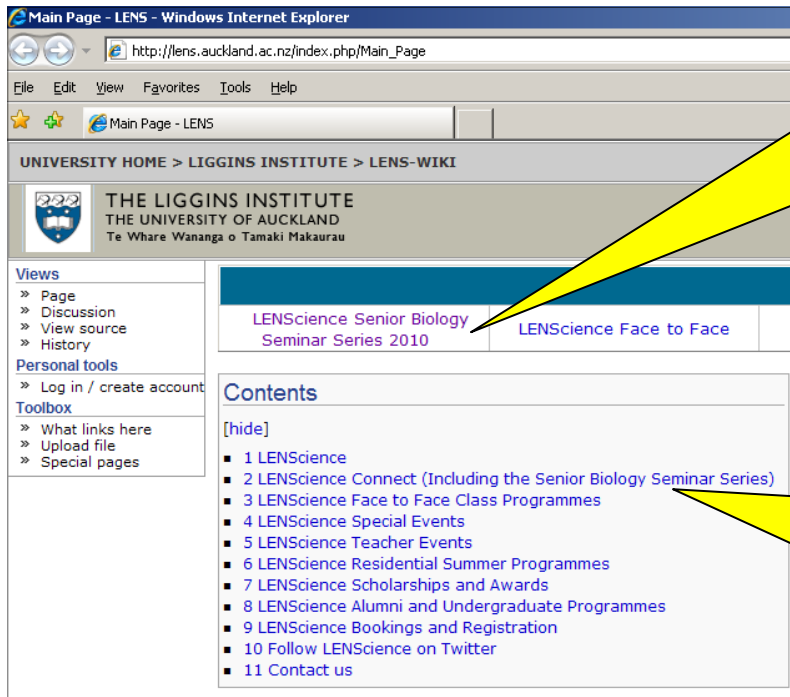




Feeling lost in the wiki?

Each seminar is only **2 clicks** away from the main page of the wiki.

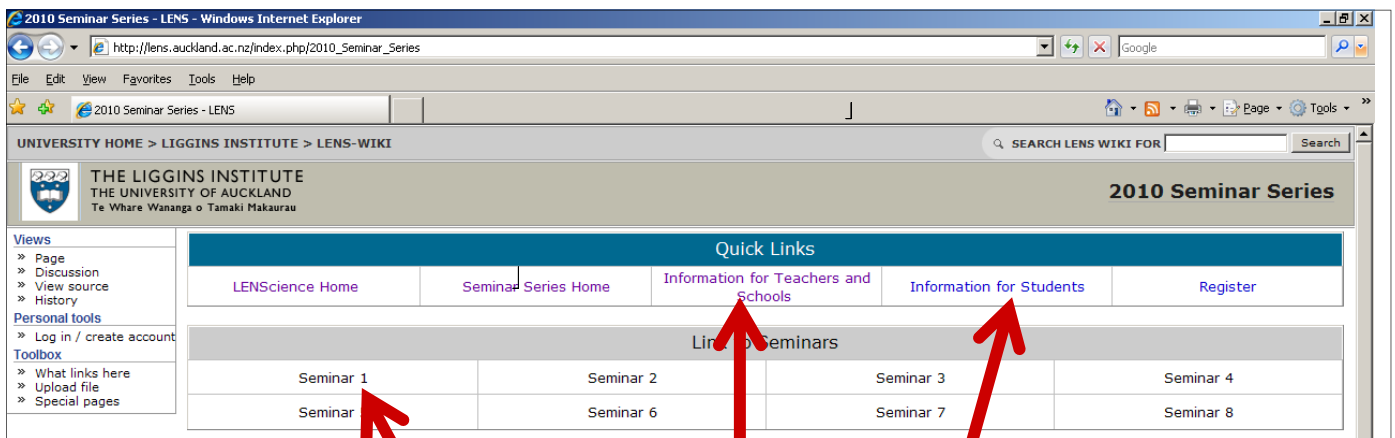

Click 1:

Click 2:

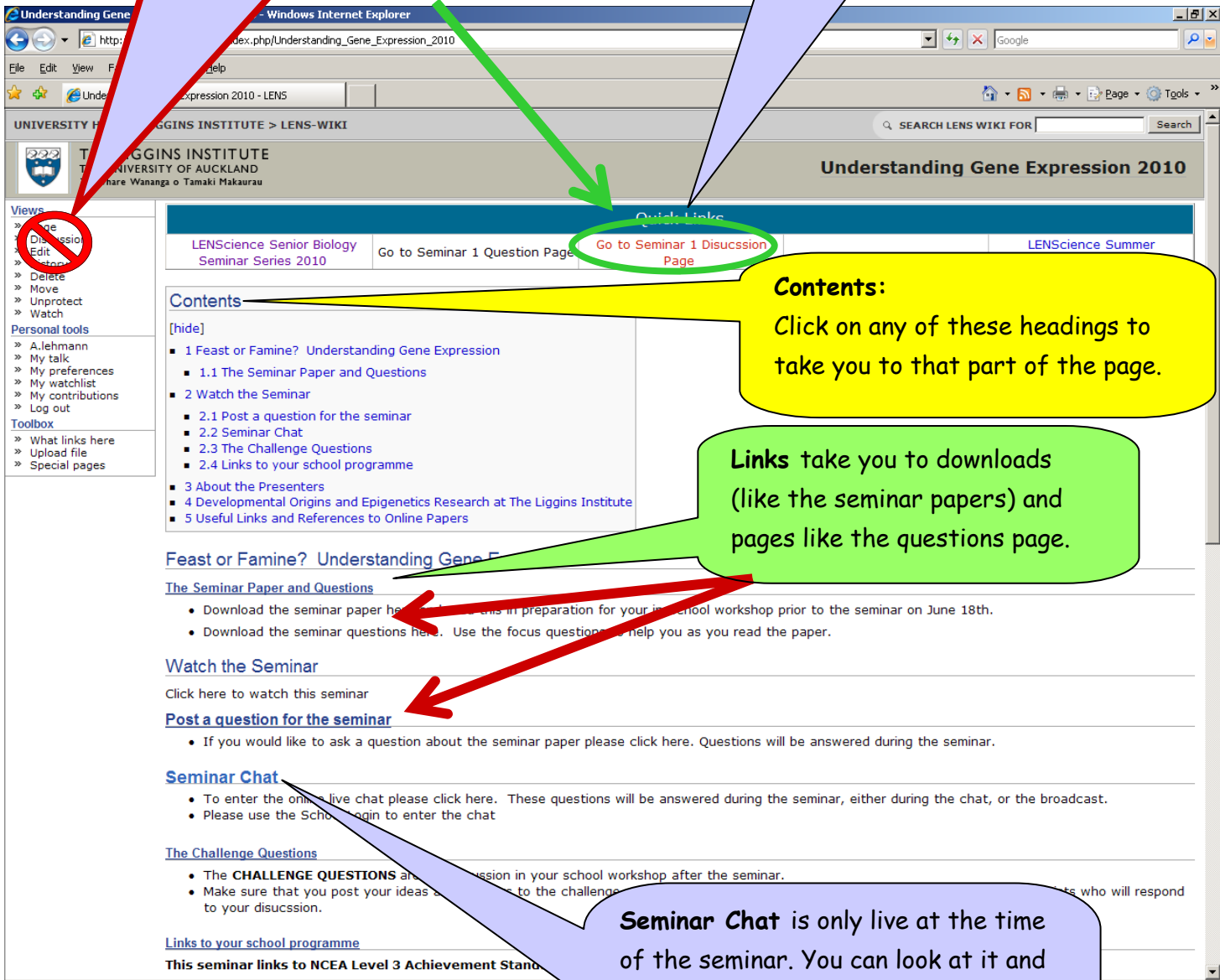

Finding your way around each seminar

Each seminar is set up the same way.....

Do not use the discussion page here—that is part of the format of this site—we cannot change it. Use the one in the Quick Links instead.....

Quick Links takes you directly to the Seminar Series main page, the seminar discussion page or the seminar question page.

Click on any of these headings to take you to that part of the page.

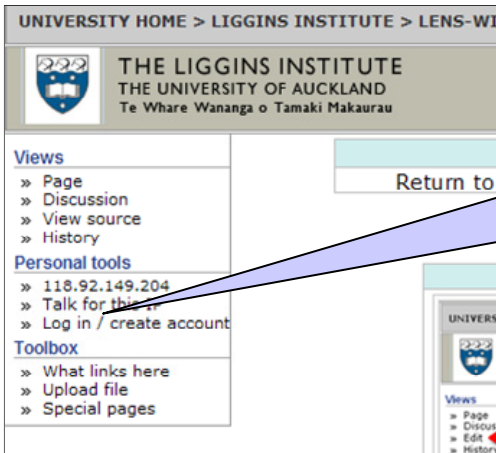
Links take you to downloads (like the seminar papers) and pages like the questions page.

Seminar Chat is only live at the time of the seminar. You can look at it and see the instructions before the seminar, but you will **ONLY** see chat **DURING** the live event. The Chat is hosted by teachers.

Finding your way around the question and discussion pages.

Step 1:

You need to be logged in to be able to add (edit) questions and answers on the discussion and question pages.



Login here using your school login that you were sent. (Students please see your teacher for your school name and password).

To Edit 2: —click EDIT on the side panel. Then follow the instructions.

To Edit 1: Read the instructions on how to edit the wiki (or watch the movie). Do this BEFORE you click Edit on the side panel.
